Equivalence of IFC Certification Installer Schemes with Warringtonfire FIRAS and BM TRADA Q-Mark (Element – formerly Exova) Schemes

To whom it may concern,

I am writing as we (IFC Certification) are informing all procurers of fire safety installer services of the equivalence of IFC Certification's certification scheme with the Warringtonfire FIRAS and BM TRADA Q-Mark (Element – formerly Exova) Schemes. As an introduction, IFC Certification (IFCC) is a provider of 3rd party certification of fire protection products and installers alongside other services such as Passive/Active Fire Protection Site Inspections.

Procurement policies relating to fire safety products/installers can sometimes be specific to a certification brand, sometimes as a product of historic continuity and sometimes as result of the absence of policy reviews. Our concern is that limiting such an important specification to one brand alone may limit the scope of choice for procurers and may impact costs, quality and diversity.

We accept that there is no obligation to accept IFCC and that your organisation may have a list of approved suppliers that may require a lot of work to extend / revise, but we would ask you to accept this letter as confirmation of the status of the IFC Certification Limited installer certification scheme being equivalent to the WCL FIRAS and BM TRADA Q-Mark (Element – formerly Exova) Installer Certification Schemes.

All three schemes are UKAS Accredited installer certification schemes which comply with the requirements of ISO/IEC 17065:2012 "Conformity Assessment – Requirement for bodies certifying products, processes and services". The IFCC UKAS Accreditation number 175 is shown above (in the head of this letter) with the UKAS mark awarded as a result of IFCC satisfactorily achieving and maintaining this accreditation, the scope of our accreditation can be reviewed on the UKAS website at the following location:

IFCC schemes are headed up by Certification Director Ian Woodhouse, and our team have over 200 years collective experience in Fire Safety.
